## **GLOSSARY**

Transparency and Comparability of Banking Charges

In order to be transparent and to help the client to compare the main banking charges, the European directive 2014/92/UE requires payment service providers to use a standardised Terminology for the most representative services linked to a payment account.

10 representative services have been chosen for Luxembourg which terms and according definitions are listed here below:

>	Account Handling	The account provider operates the client account for use.
>	Providing a debit card	The account provider provides the client with a payment card linked to his account.
		The total amount of the transactions is taken in full from the customer's payment
		account on an agreed date.
>	Providing a credit card	The account provider provides the client with a payment card linked to the client's
		Payment account. On an agreed date the total amount of transactions used on the
		card is taken in full from the client's account.
>	Temporary	The account provider my allow the customer to borrow money where there is no
	overdraft	more money left with an agreed rate.
>	Fund transfer	The account providers executes transactions on instruction of the client from the
		client's account to another another account.
>	Standing Order	The account provider executes on a regular basis transactions based on the
		instructions from the client from the client's account to another account.
>	Direct Debit	The client permits another person to instruct the account provider to transfer money
		from the client's account to the one of the recipient. The account provider vires the
		money to the recipient on a date agreed by the client and the recipient.
>	Cash Withdrawal	The client takes cash out of his account.
>	e-banking	The account provider makes an online access available to the customer.
>	Account Statement	The account provider makes an account statement available to the customer.
